

**Oxon Link Road Between A5 And B4380 Holyhead Road Shrewsbury
Planning Application Reference: 18/03166/EIA**

I wish to strongly object to the proposed application for the Oxon Link Road as submitted to the Council. I am very concerned that the application fails to protect Oxon Touring and Holiday Home Park. The application does not provide noise protection for the park or any safe means of crossing the road. As proposed, families and young children will be placed in a very dangerous situation. This is wholly unacceptable.

I would urge the Council to amend the application to provide a crossing/footbridge for Oxon Touring and Holiday Home Park. I would also urge the Council to ensure that controls will be put in place during construction and once the road is open, to protect Oxon Touring and Holiday Home Park from noise, dust and disturbance. Morris Leisure are one of the principal tourism advocates in Shropshire and should be supported. If Officers are unable to amend the application to protect local businesses, such as Oxon Touring and Holiday Home Park, this application should be refused.
